
Dear Mr. McColough:

Your letter to the Mayor of the City of Halifax was forwarded to us two days ago.

We do not have a genealogy of the McColough family and the province of Nova Scotia did not keep either immigration or emigration lists. However, we are enclosing the information which we have been able to find from St. Matthew's Presbyterian Church Records and from the 1871 Census. We are also enclosing a copy of the will of Archibald McCulloch who probably was the father of your ancestor.

Might I point out that the date on the original letter from Andrew Mackinley was probably not clear. The date should be 1852 because Mackinlay was Mayor from 1845-46 and 1851-52.
